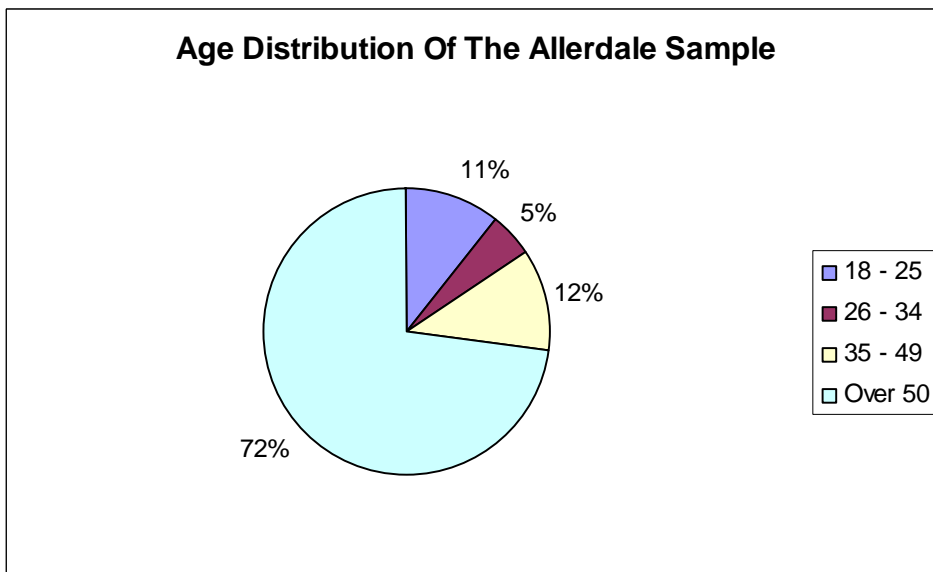


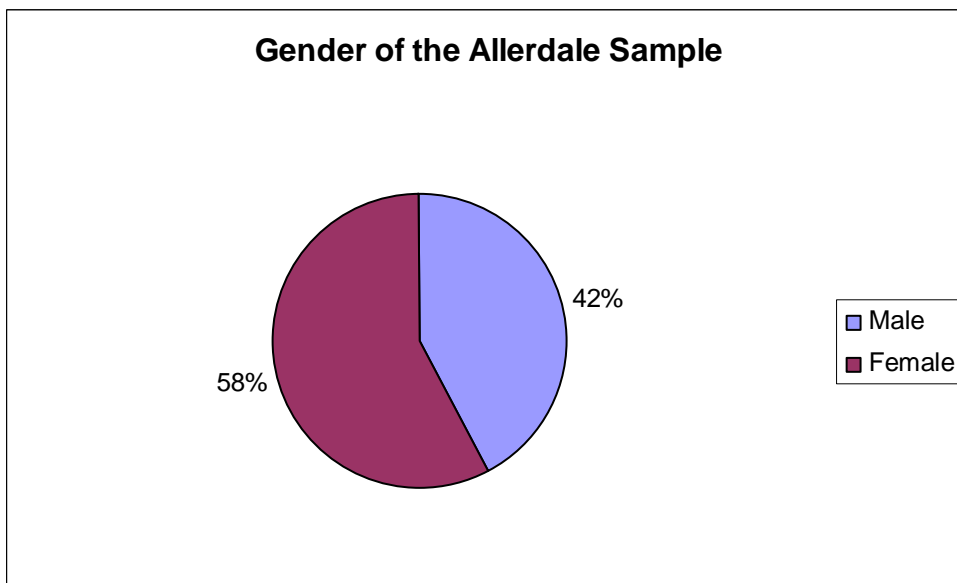
1.1 Demographics of the Respondents to the Police Public Consultation Survey

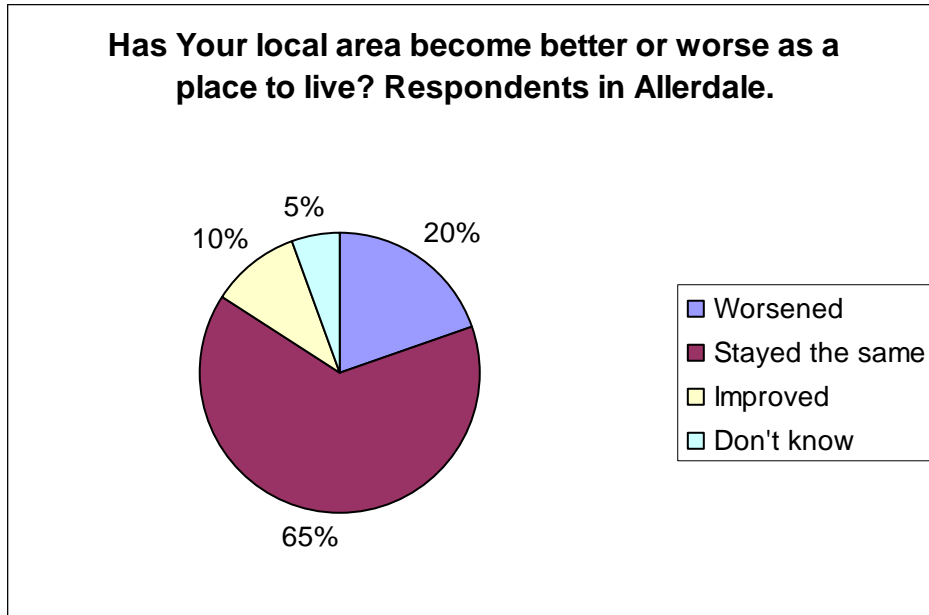

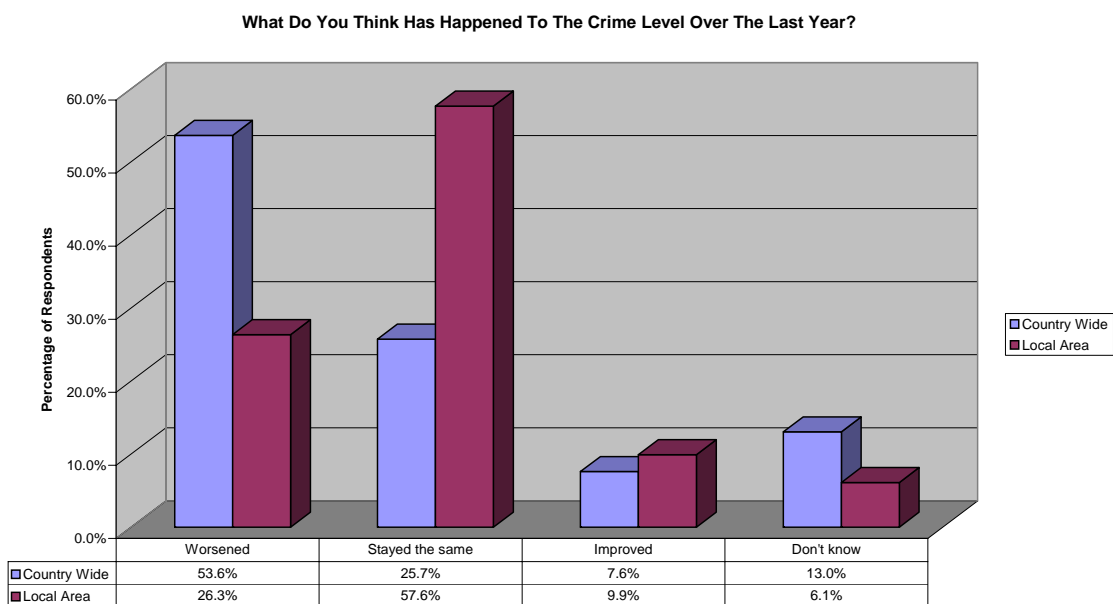

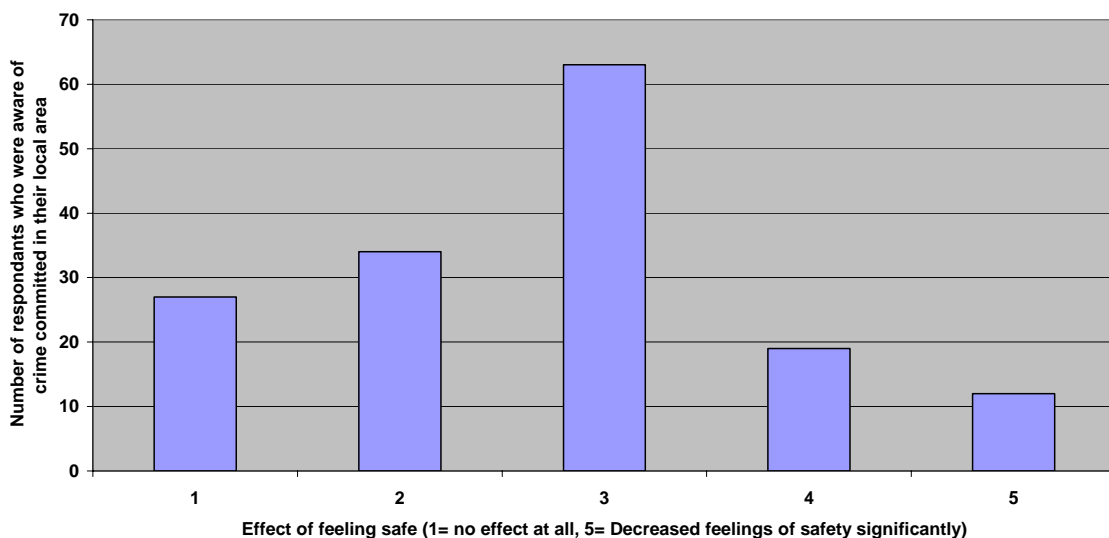

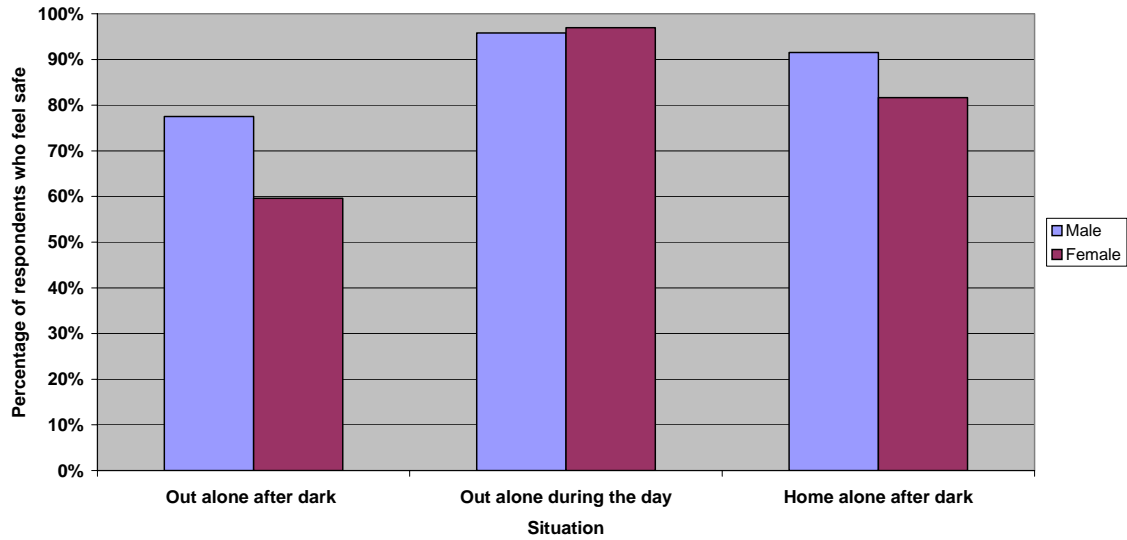

Bar Chart to show the number of respondents who were aware of crime committed in Allerdale and the effect it had on their feeling of safety.



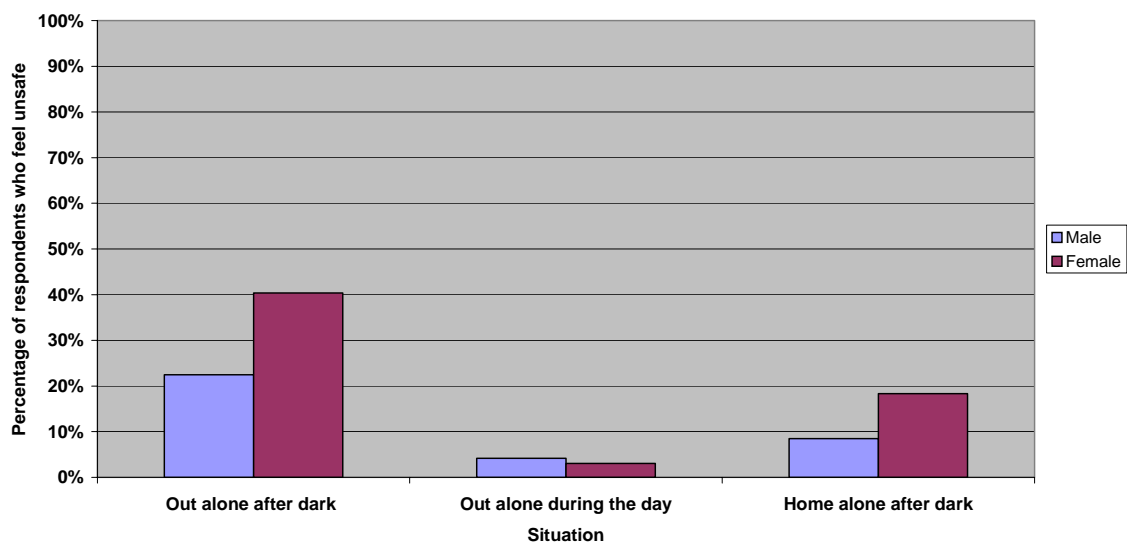
1.2.5 Bar chart to show the percentage of respondents from Allerdale by Gender who feel safe in certain situations. (Question 6).

Bar chart to show the percentage of respondents from Allerdale by Gender who feel safe in certain situations.



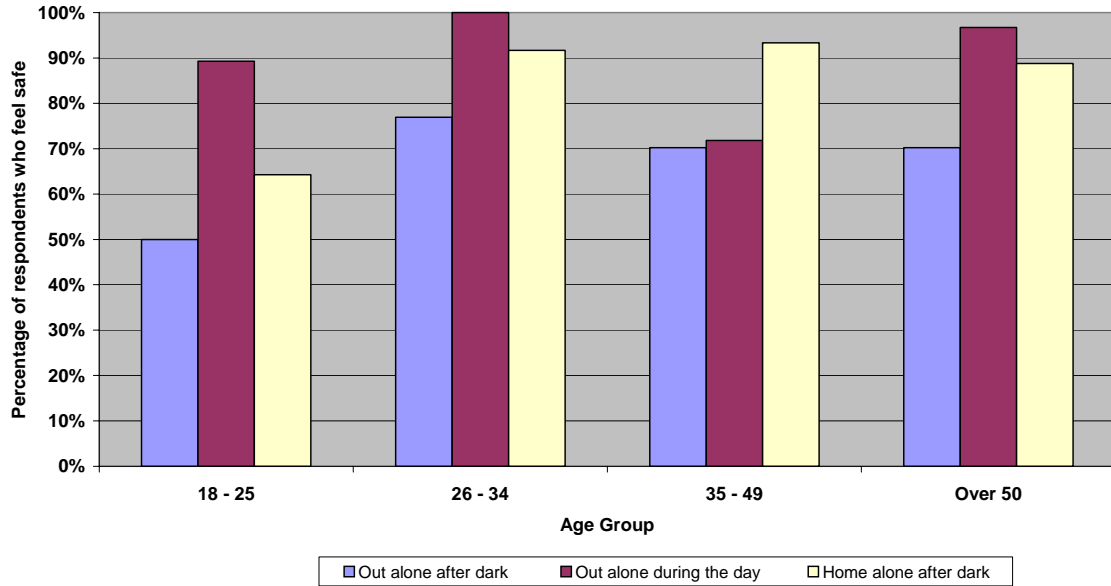
1.2.6 Bar chart to show the percentage of respondents from Allerdale by Gender who feel unsafe in certain situations. (Question 6)

Bar chart to show the percentage of respondents from Allerdale by Gender who feel unsafe in certain situations.



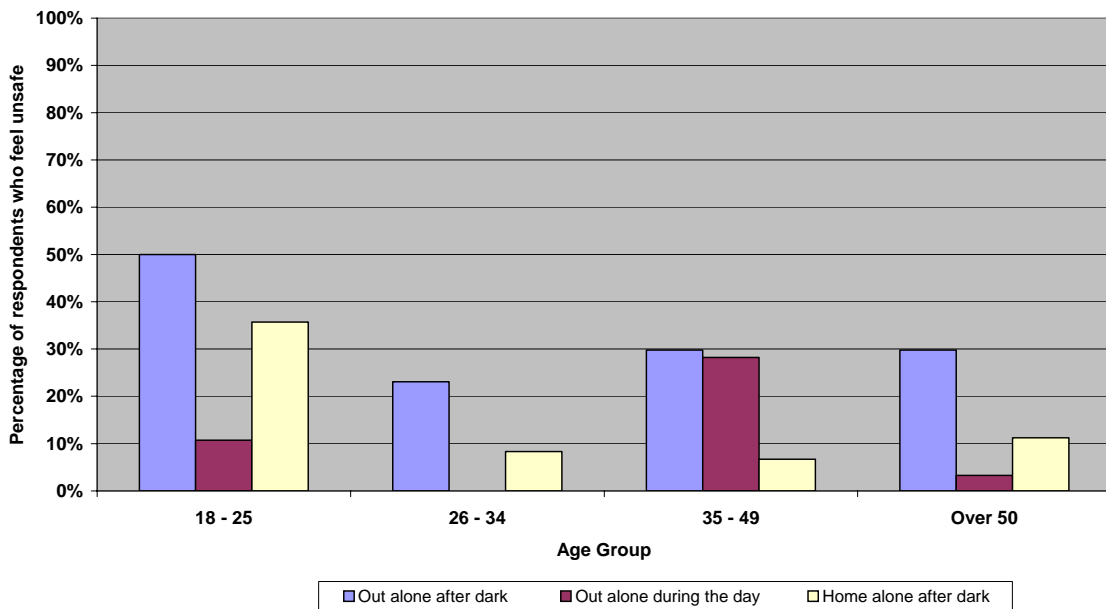
1.2.7 Bar Chart to show how safe respondents from Allerdale feel by Age Groups. (Question 6).

Bar Chart to show how safe respondents from Allerdale feel by Age Groups



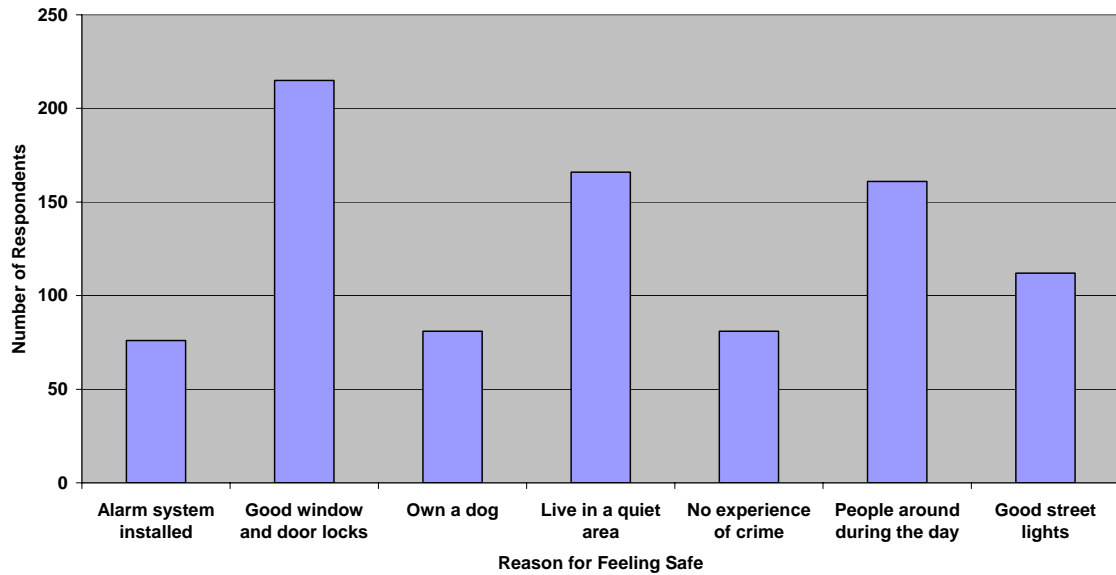
1.2.8 Bar Chart to show how unsafe respondents from Allerdale feel by Age Groups. (Question 6).

Bar Chart to show how unsafe respondents from Allerdale feel by Age Groups



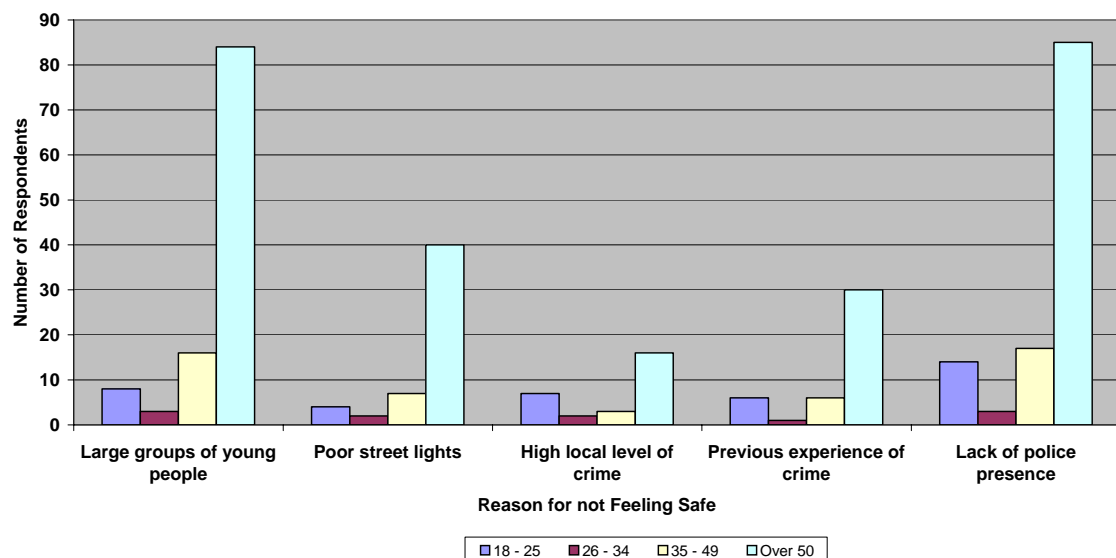

Bar Chart to show the reasons respondents in Allerdale gave for feeling safe .



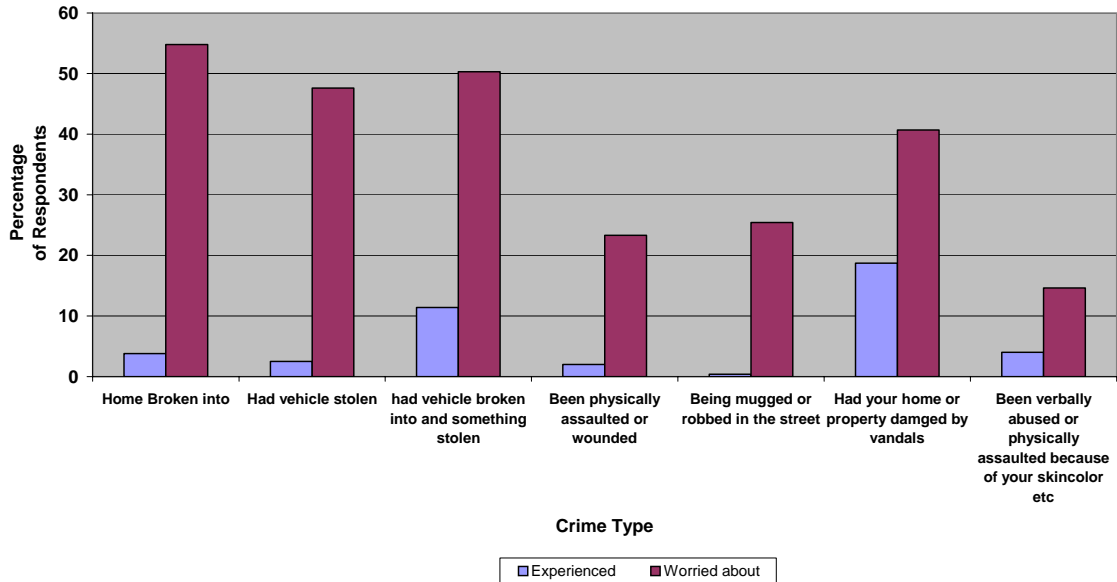
1.2.10 Bar Chart to show the reasons respondents in Allerdale gave for not feeling safe by Age Groupings. (Question 8 from the survey).

Bar Chart to show the reasons respondents in Allerdale gave for not feeling safe by Age Groupings



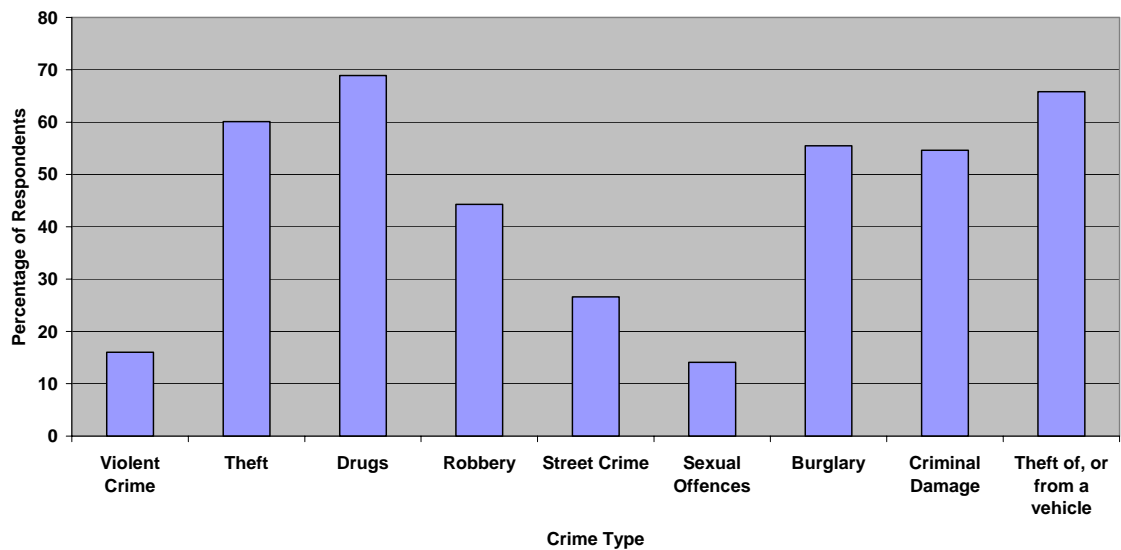
