GUIDANCE IN RESPECT OF REHABILITATION OF OFFENDERS ACT, 1974 –
Enquiry 7

If the rehabilitation period has expired since you completed a sentence and have not been convicted of any subsequent offence (other than a summary offence) the original conviction is spent and need not be disclosed.

Sentences which cannot be spent

Life Imprisonment

Corrective Training for more than 2 ½ years

Preventive Detention

Detention during Her Majesty's Pleasure, or for life, or for more than 2 ½ years

<u>Sentence</u>	<u>Rehabilitation Period</u>
Imprisonment or corrective training for 6-30 months	10 years
Imprisonment for less than 6 months	7 years
Any fine	5 years
Borstal Training	7 years
Detention for 6-30 months or up to six months under S.53 C.Y.P. Act, 1933	5 years or 3 years
Absolute Discharge	6 months
Conditional Discharge, Bind Over or Probation Order	One year or for the period of the order whichever is the longer

All periods are reduced by half where the offender was under 17.
