The Leisure Access Card

The Leisure Access Card enables you to claim points for each activity that you participate in. The more you use it, the more points you earn which can be redeemed against a whole host of activities. You can also benefit from paying the discounted price for swimming at Keswick Leisure Pool all year round.

The Priority Leisure Access Card

The Priority Leisure Access Card offers the same benefits as the Leisure Access Card but also enables those who qualify to receive up to a 50% discount on standard pay per visit prices at Workington Leisure Centre, Cockermouth Leisure Centre and Keswick Leisure Pool and at our other facilities in and around Carlisle.

What is included? - It is easier to list the activities that aren't! All pay as you play activities are included so you can use your card at all of the gyms, pools, exercise classes, most sports, golf, tennis and much more.

Who is eligible? - Leisure Access Cards are available to all adults and children up to 17 years of age currently resident in the Borough of Allerdale. A resident is defined as a person paying Council Tax to Allerdale Borough Council.

To qualify for a Priority Leisure Access Card you must fall into one of the following categories:

Students including Student Nurses:

Must be full time, aged over 16, and have an appropriate stamp from school, college or university confirming full time status. Not applicable to vocational study students.

Senior Citizens Over 60: Benefit Recipients:

Birth Certificate, Pension Book or Bus Pass. Job Seekers Allowance, Income Support, Incapacity Benefit, Employment and Support Allowance (ESA), Government Training Schemes, Housing Benefit.

Qualifying stamp obtainable from your local Job Centre Plus office

How do I get one? - Simply fill in this application form and take it to your local centre and we will process it for you. It will take about a week to make your card, which will be posted to your home address.

What do I need to bring? - You need the £5 fee, one passport sized photograph and we will need to see proof of your residency and also status if you are applying for the Priority Leisure Access Card.

How long does the card last? - The card, once produced, is valid for 12 months or if you are claiming priority status, whenever this ceases. If your priority qualification does end you are obliged to inform us immediately. We also reserve the right to request on the spot proof of qualification and to withdraw the card, both at our discretion.

Renewing the card? - Simply bring along the card to any of the Allerdale facilities with a £2.50 renewal fee and if you are renewing a Priority Leisure Access Card proof of your continued priority status will be required. We do not send out reminders on expiry.
